



What you need:

- Finished DVD Studio Pro project
- Subtitles file (.zip)

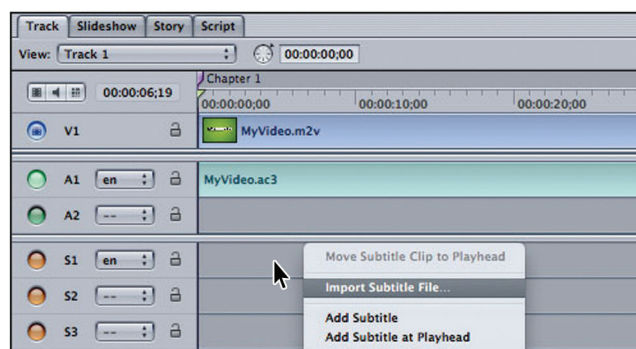
Each track will require its own subtitles .zip file.

Step 1: Unzip your subtitles

- Place the .zip file in your project folder.
- Double-click on the file to unzip it.
- The folder it creates should contain:
 - .son file or .stl file (for timing information)
 - Graphic files for each individual subtitle (.tif)

Step 2: Import subtitles

- In your DVD Studio Pro track, right-click on the S1 (Subtitle 1) track. Select Import Subtitle File.



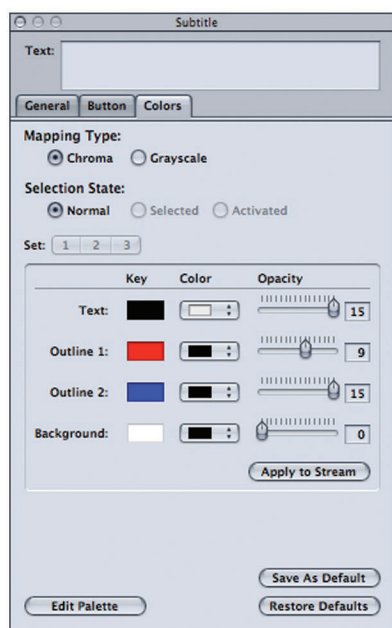
- Navigate to your unzipped subtitles folder for this track.
- Select your .son or .stl file and click Choose.

(NOTE: If you get an error that subtitles are out of range, this indicates a discrepancy between the asset timing of your m2v and the timecode on the video we were given to create your subtitle file.)
- Set the language setting for the subtitle track using the drop-down menu next to "S1"

(example: en = english subtitles)

Step 3: Adjust color settings

- Zoom into the subtitle track and double-click on one of the subtitle graphics.



- In the inspector, click on the Colors tab.
- Adjust your color settings:

Mapping Type:	Chroma
Text (black):	Set color to White with 15 opacity.
Outline 1 (red):	Set color to Black with 9 opacity.
Outline 2 (blue):	Set color to Black with 15 opacity.
Background (white):	Set color to Black with 0 opacity.
- Click Apply to Stream.
